Scanned Collage - "About Me"

- You'll be creating a collage by arranging items on a scanner, scanning the items, and manipulating the scanned image to achieve the artistic effect you want.
- Choose items to scan that represent YOU:
 - o important events in your life,
 - interests and hobbies
 - o special memories
- These items may include
 - photographs
 - drawings
 - o postcards, greeting cards
 - o awards,
 - small 3D objects such as trophies, medals, badges. mobile phone, CDs, textured fabric, lucky charms, trinkets, soft toys, small packets, (Objects should not be too big in depth/height because only the bottom surface will scan)
- You only need 6-8 items.
- The complete collage will need to fit on the top of our scanner. Therefore, the objects should be fairly small. Think about the best way to arrange the objects before they are scanned. Sketch out design ideas in your visual diary.
- Ensure objects are not placed directly on the glass surface, protect it with the plastic sheet
- Do NOT attempt to force the scanner lid closed. Leaving the lid up will result in a dark background behind your items. Otherwise, cover your collection with a piece of paper/cardboard or fabric for the light to bounce off and maintain that particular coloured background.
- Your first name should be incorporated in some way as part of the collage.
- Use Photoshop to manipulate your collage, include layers, selection techniques, adjustments and filters
